## Wearing a mask becomes mandatory in Leverkusen and NRW

From monday, April 27th 2020, it becomes mandatory to wear a mask in certain situations in public life in Leverkusen and NRW.

When a minimum distance of 1,50 m between two persons cannot be guaranteed, there is an obligation to wear a mask: in shops, in banks and in public transportation (trains and buses). Since the beginning of april, wearing a mask is also mandatory in buildings of Leverkusen's city administration.

The use of scarfs and self-sewn masks is allowed. The requirement is that mouth and nose are covered.

Wearing a mask is mandatory from april 27th. Yet citizens are requested to wear a mask from now on.
